New Programs

NO ACTION IS REQUIRED ON THE PART OF THE HOUSING COMMISSION

A workshop will be held at the April 7, 2017, meeting regarding proposed new programs of HOUSING FIRST – SAN DIEGO, the San Diego Housing Commission’s (Housing Commission) Homelessness Action Plan. The Housing Commission is proposing an expansion of programs and funding to help address the needs of up to 3,000 homeless individuals and families over the next three years through six programs. An estimated \$78.7 million will be directed to support:

- Homeless Prevention & Diversion Services
- Coordinated Street Outreach for Coordinated Entry
- Expanded Landlord Engagement
- Additional Rapid Re-Housing Assistance
- New Permanent Supportive Housing
- Introduction of a “Moving On” Rental Assistance Program

No action will be taken on this item.
