Landlord Engagement and Assistance Program (LEAP)

The Landlord Engagement and Assistance Program (LEAP) provides incentives to landlords with rental properties in the City of San Diego (ZIP Code 92037 and ZIP Codes that begin with 921, excluding 92118) who rent to homeless families and individuals.

More than \$6.6 million over three years will be directed to LEAP of **HOUSING FIRST – SAN DIEGO: 2018-2020**, the San Diego Housing Commission's homelessness action plan, to create permanent housing opportunities for 3,000 households.

Landlords are important partners in HOUSING FIRST – SAN DIEGO: 2018-2020.

Incentives include:

- **Pre-inspection** Certification good for 60 days, unit does not need to be occupied
- **Payments** \$500 for the first apartment rented to a homeless family or individual, \$250 for each additional unit
- **Contingency Fund** Up to \$1.5 million set aside to help landlords cover expenses upon move-out, such as repairs that exceed security deposits or rent due to unforeseen vacancies
- Security Deposits/Utility Assistance An average of \$1,500 in security deposits and \$100 in utility assistance per household

- Free Online Rental Listings Including photos, map and information about rents and community information
- Application/Credit Check Assistance Financial assistance for credit checks and application fees
- **Tenant placement assistance** SDHC database helps match landlords and tenants
- Landlord selects tenant applicant Landlords retain the right to pre-screen and select the tenants
- Landlord liaison SDHC housing specialists answer landlords' questions.
