



Free Tax Preparation

With the 2010 tax season fast approaching, did you know that if you earned less than \$49,000 you can have your taxes done for FREE? Our tax preparers have been certified by the IRS and the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program can help you get the largest refund possible. In addition, we can help you receive the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC), up to \$450 for single persons with no children and up to \$5,600 for persons with children.

These are items you will need to bring when you have your taxes done, (if applicable):

- Social Security cards and birth dates for all taxpayers and dependents
- Photo Identification
- All tax forms received from employers and banks (i.e. W-2, 1098, & 1099's)
- Copy of your 2009 federal tax return, if you have one available
- Information for all deductions or credits
- Information for other income or expenses
- Total paid for day care services & day care provider's tax ID number
- Bank routing number and account number, if direct deposit of refund is desired

Achievement Academy's Family Self-Sufficiency Program

The Achievement Academy's core program is Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS), a five-year voluntary program available to families and individuals currently receiving federal Housing Choice Vouchers (Section 8) from the San Diego Housing Commission and those living in our public housing properties.

FSS provides participants with a wide array of services, such as financial literacy education, job training, career planning, book scholarships, small business start-up training and referrals, and homeownership programs.
