SUBJECT: Workshop & Discussion – Pathways to Homelessness Among Participants in
SDHC-Administered Homelessness Services Programs

An informational workshop will present survey results from participants in SDHC-administered and City-funded homelessness services programs. No action will be taken on this item.

SDHC staff from the Homelessness Housing Innovations team conducted a 2024 survey of participants in SDHC-administered homelessness services programs. The survey aimed to gather demographic information, identify causes of homelessness, and assess interventions that could have prevented participants' episodes of homelessness.

Surveys were completed by 711 participants at 12 different programs, including three site-based services programs and nine shelter programs. The informational workshop will provide an overview of the survey findings.
