A RESOLUTION OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE OPERATING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SAN DIEGO HOUSING COMMISSION AND ST. VINCENT DE PAUL VILLAGE, INC., DBA FATHER JOE'S VILLAGES TO OVERSEE, ADMINISTER, AND MANAGE THE TEMPORARY BRIDGE SHELTER PROGRAM LOCATED AT 202 C STREET (GOLDEN HALL), AUTHORIZING EXPANSION OF THE PROGRAM, APPROVING FUNDING AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) and the San Diego Housing Commission (Housing Commission) are parties to that certain Memorandum of Understanding for the Provision of Temporary Bridge Shelters (MOU), which was approved by the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Housing Authority) with Housing Authority Resolution HA-1859, on June 16, 2020, and by the San Diego City Council (City Council) with San Diego Resolution R-313111, on June 18, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the MOU provides for administration of four temporary bridge shelter programs in the Barrio Logan, Midway, Core-Columbia, and East Village neighborhoods (collectively, Shelter Programs); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the MOU and Housing Authority Resolution HA-1859, the Housing Commission signed four agreements for operation of the Shelter Programs; and

WHEREAS, to provide an additional 280 beds for single adults, the Housing

Commission staff wishes to amend the operating agreement with St. Vincent de Paul Village,

Inc., dba Father Joe's Villages located at 202 C Street, Golden Hall (Golden Hall Shelter

Amendment); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority as follows:

Authorize the execution of the Golden Hall Shelter Amendment in the amount of

\$2,920,869.87.

2. The President & CEO, or designee, is authorized to execute any documents and

instruments that are necessary and appropriate to implement this Resolution, in a form approved

by Housing Commission General Counsel and to take such actions necessary and appropriate to

implement these approvals without further action of the Board of Commissioners of the Housing

Commission Board (Housing Commission Board) or the Housing Authority.

3. The President & CEO, or designee, is authorized to substitute funding sources,

increase compensation, or both, not to exceed twenty percent (20%) of the total cost for the

Golden Hall Shelter Amendment, without further action by Housing Commission Board or the

Housing Authority, but only if and to the extent funds are determined to be available for such

purposes.
