## **TOPICS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION**

The Housing Commission and Planning Commission will meet jointly to discuss the following issues:

- I. **Subject - Revision to the Housing Element of the Progress Guide and General Plan. (Council District - Citywide) (HCR96-001 PC96-006) [See companion Item 4 on the Planning Commission Agenda of January 11, 1996]**

**Recommendation** - Recommend approval to the City Council of a General Plan Amendment to the 1991-1998 Housing Element Update that is being proposed pursuant to Government Code Section 65583(c)(1) and in accordance with a court order in Superior Court Case No. 682920, Hoffmaster, et al. v. City, et al. issued on October 30, 1995.

This amendment would be for the purpose of adding maps and text to more fully describe the need for emergency shelters and transitional housing. It would also describe the City's existing programs and development regulations for these facilities, and the location of existing facilities.

II. **Workshop - Joint Meeting with the Planning Commission. [See companion Item 4A on the Planning Commission Agenda of January 11, 1996]**

**Subject - Fiscal Year 1997 City of San Diego Consolidated Annual Plan (Citywide) (HCR96-002 P96-007)**

The purpose of the workshop is to discuss common issues facing both the Planning Commission and the Housing Commission in the discharge of their duties. The focus of today's workshop will be the **CONSOLIDATED PLAN** required by the Federal Government as an application for HUD funds. The Consolidated Plan contains the overall Community Development Framework for the City.
