A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AWARD AND EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE SAN DIEGO HOUSING COMMISSION AND STRONGHOLD ENGINEERING, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,291,027, FOR SOUND ATTENUATION AND ENERGY EFFICIENCY UPGRADES AT MAYA APARTMENTS, A COMMISSIONOWNED SITE, PLUS A TEN PERCENT CONTINGENCY, IF NECESSARY

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2011, the San Diego Housing Commission issued an Invitation for Bids for sound attenuation and energy efficiency upgrades at the Maya Apartments, located at 10101-10191 Maya Linda Road, San Diego, California (Maya Apartments), a Commission-owned site, and received two (2) responses on December 21, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission determined that the bid response presented by Stronghold Engineering, Inc., provides the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, as described in San Diego Housing Commission Report 12-001, the San Diego Housing Commission approved the award of a contract to Stronghold Engineering, Inc., for sound attenuation and energy efficiency upgrades at the Maya Apartments, on January 20, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the total proposed amount for said contract is \$2,291,027; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The San Diego Housing Commission is authorized to award a contract for sound attenuation and energy efficiency upgrades at the Maya Apartments, a Commission-owned site, to Stronghold Engineering, Inc., in the amount of \$2,291,027.

2. The President and Chief Executive Officer of the San Diego Housing

Commission, or his designee, is authorized to execute said contract in a form

approved by the Housing Commission's General Counsel, and to perform such

acts necessary to implement the approvals herein.

3. The President and Chief Executive Officer of the San Diego Housing

Commission, or his designee, is authorized to expend up to a ten percent

contingency in the amount of \$229,103 for items not anticipated in the original
scope of work.

4. This action is categorically exempt from the provisions of California

Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section

15301 (existing facilities). Processing under the National Environmental Policy

Act (NEPA) is not required as no federal funds are implicated in this activity.

5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
