DISCUSSION

The SDHC Achievement Academy has developed new programming to assist families with young adults and children. The new programs include:

- Hard skills training: Workforce development with resume writing, interviewing techniques, mock interviews, job search skills, and basic writing skills
- Financial education: credit report and budgeting classes, one-on-one financial coaching, and assistance with credit issues
- Multigenerational programming
- Summer reading program for out-of-school children
- Weekly recruitments with top employers in San Diego
