- No Management Letter Comments






SDHC – FY 2024 Annual Financial Audit Report Financial Results Summary

- Total revenues: \$505.5 million
 - U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) & U.S. Treasury Department grants:
 75% of revenues
- Total expenses: \$469.2 million
 - Housing Assistance Expenses: \$291.3 million
 - Grant Expenses: \$69.9 million
 - Other Expenses: \$108.0 million
- Total multifamily and homeownership loans funded: \$19.5 million

SDHC – FY 2024 Annual Financial Audit Report Net Position Categories

- Net Investment in Capital Assets: \$196.6 million
 - The amount spent on capital assets and is used for operations
- Restricted Net Position: \$247.6 million
 - This amount is restricted by external creditors, grantors, contributors, or laws or regulations of other governments.
- Unrestricted Net Position: \$459.3 million
 - This balance is <u>not</u> indicative of funds available for discretionary use.
 - GASB (accounting) definitions require this amount to be classified as "unrestricted net position" for financial reporting on the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR).

SDHC – FY 2024 Annual Financial Audit Report SDHC Operational Highlights

Rental Assistance Division

Federal Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers (HCV):

- Over 17,000 households received rental assistance
- 280 Federal Project-Based vouchers awarded to serve residents with low-income or experiencing homelessness
- Paid more than \$663,000 in security deposit loans
- 825 households received mobility counseling and assistance
- Provided assistance to more than 300 households displaced by floods through the Flood Recovery Program

SDHC Achievement Academy:

- 1,257 participants received core services
- 231 participants placed in jobs, and 255 participants increased earnings
- \$20.50 average hourly wage of participants
- More than 1,260 participants attended 255 workshops on various topics





SDHC – FY 2024 Annual Financial Audit Report SDHC Operational Highlights (Continued)

Real Estate Division

- Acquisition of Pacific Village, providing 62 new affordable housing units for individuals who
 experienced homelessness and transition-age youth.
- Own and manage 152 properties, with 2,446 affordable rental housing units.
- Completed 6 affordable housing partnership developments in the City of San Diego, which created 525 affordable housing rental units.





SDHC – FY 2024 Annual Financial Audit Report SDHC Operational Highlights (Continued)

Homeless Housing Innovations

- Administered the City's homelessness shelters and services programs
- Assisted over 700 eligible low-income tenants facing eviction, through the Eviction Prevention Program
- Operated the Homelessness Response Center
- Administered Continuum of Care-funded Permanent Supportive Housing and Rapid Rehousing programs
- Continued to lead homelessness prevention efforts with the Housing Instability Prevention Program (HIPP) and the Prevention and Diversion program
- Continued oversight of several supportive services programs, such as the Multidisciplinary
 Outreach Team, Storage Connect Centers, Program for Engaged Educational Resources (PEER)
 and the Day Center
