A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR ULRIC STREET APARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Authority) intends to issue not to exceed \$34,930,321 principal amount of multifamily housing revenue bonds (Bonds) to finance the acquisition and construction of Ulric Street Apartments, a multifamily affordable housing project in the City of San Diego (City) described in the Notice of Public Hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Bonds are expected to be issued in three series, and it is expected that the interest on two of the series of the Bonds to be issued in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$28,930,321 (the Tax-Exempt Bonds), will be excludable from the gross income of the owner of the Tax-Exempt Bonds for purposes of federal income taxation; and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Tax-Exempt Bonds to be tax-exempt, section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Code) requires that the Tax-Exempt Bonds be approved by the City Council as the applicable elected representative after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing regarding the issuance of the Tax-Exempt Bonds and the financing of the Project on June 25, 2019, and following the public hearing the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-312546, with a date of final passage of July 8, 2019 approving the issuance of the Tax-Exempt Bonds by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, applicable United States Treasury Regulations (Regulations) require that the

City Council's approval of the Tax-Exempt Bonds occur within one year of their issuance by the

Authority, and because the Authority will issue the Tax-Exempt Bonds more than one year after

the City Council's July 8, 2019 approval of their issuance, the City Council now desires to again

approve the issuance of the Tax-Exempt Bonds by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, one or more notice(s) of a public hearing with respect to the proposed

issuance of the Bonds were timely published in accordance with the Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the new public hearing was held on September 29, 2020, and an opportunity

was provided for interested persons to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds and on

the nature and location of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that this City Council,

as the applicable elected representative under section 147(f) of the Code, approves the issuance

by the Authority of the Bonds, including the issuance of the Tax-Exempt Bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City does not warrant the creditworthiness of the

Bonds or guarantee, in any way, the payment of the Bonds. No moneys of the City will be

pledged or applied to the repayment of the Bonds.

The owner of the Project is expected to be Ulric Street Housing Associates, L.P., a California limited partnership. The manager of the facility when it has been completed will be ConAm Management Corporation or another entity selected by the owner of the Project. Ninety-five of the units in the Project are expected to be income and rent restricted and will be occupied by low or very low-income tenants at affordable rents.

It is expected that the interest on up to \$28,930,321 principal amount of the Bonds will be excludable from the gross income of the owner of such portion of the Bonds for purposes of federal income taxes.
