REQUESTED ACTION:

Housing Commission confirmation of the nominations by the Chair for appointments to the Loan Committee pursuant to Housing Commission Loan Committee Policy 600.102.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Appointment of Brian Wood, and reappointment of Jahi Akobundu, Linnie Arcangel Gavino, Rosemary Johnston, Joseph Frederick Oliver, Paul Shipstead and Nicole Wright, to the Loan Committee for two-year terms.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Housing Commission Loan Committee Policy 600.102, the Loan Committee is made up of seven members. Efforts are made to include nominees from the real estate, building, financial and legal professions, as well as at least one representative from a community-based nonprofit and/or a community planning group.

There are presently six members serving on the Loan Committee, they are:

Loan Committee Policy states that nominations by the Chair are to be approved by the Housing Commission Board. It is recommended that Jahi Akobundu, Linnie Arcangel Gavino, Rosemary Johnston, Joseph Frederick Oliver, Paul Shipstead and Nicole Wright be reappointed for a two-year term.
