SUBJECT: Authorization to accept and utilize American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Grant

Funds (Citywide)

REQUESTED ACTION:

That the Housing Commission authorize the President & Chief Executive Officer or designee to accept funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 Public Housing Capital Fund in the amount of \$2,173,051 and authorize the proposed use of same to provide additional public housing units in the City of San Diego, pursuant to the provisions of San Diego Municipal Code Section 98.0301(d).

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

- Recommend that the Housing Commission authorize the President & Chief Executive Officer or designee to accept the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 Public Housing Capital Fund Grant, available to the Commission, in the amount of \$2,173,051 pursuant to the provision of San Diego Municipal Code Section 98.0301(d).
- 2) Authorize the President & Chief Executive Officer or designee to authorize the proposed use of said grant funds in accordance with approved Business Plan and applicable policies.
- 3) Include the funding in the FY2010 budget currently being developed.

BACKGROUND:

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) established the Capital Fund program to provide financial assistance to housing authorities to improve the physical condition and upgrade the management and operation of existing public housing projects to assure that such projects continue to be available as affordable housing for eligible residents.

On or about February 17, 2009, President Barak Obama signed into effect the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. Notably, the act provides an additional \$4 billion for the Public Housing Capital Fund to carry out capital and management activities for Public Housing Agencies, as authorized under Section 9 of the United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C 1437g) (the "Act").

On or about February 24, 2009, HUD notified the San Diego Housing Commission that it is eligible to receive \$2,173,051 in Federal funds under the ARRA. This award has been identified, through Annual Contributions Contract (ACC) Amendment, as Grant Number CA16S06350109.

As a requirement for receiving the grant, not later than April 10, 2009, PHAs are to submit a Capital Fund Annual Statement Form 50075.1 describing the specific activities that they will undertake with the ARRA grant funds (Attachment 1). In addition, also by April 10, 2009, PHAs will be required to submit a resolution from their governing Board with their Capital Fund Annual Statement for the ARRA grant funding (Attachment 3). San Diego Municipal Code Section 98.0301(d) provides in pertinent part:

"Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Section 98.0301(d)(8), in circumstances where it is not feasible to obtain review and approval by the Housing Authority on or before the established deadline, the Executive Director shall have the authority to execute documents required to be executed by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") or other agencies in a timely matter in order to meet any deadlines imposed by those agencies."

In this instance the time parameters to accept this grant of in excess of Two Million dollars will not allow time for the Housing Authority to approve this matter. Accordingly, the Executive Director (now the Chief Executive Officer) has the authority to execute documents to allow for the acceptance of this Grant. However, HUD requires a resolution and for that reason, this matter is being scheduled for hearing and approval before the Commission. After the monies are received, the funds will be placed in the FY 2010 budget and the Housing Authority will have the ability to weigh in on the ratification of the expenditure of the funds.

The proposed work under this grant will be for the acquisition and/or development of new Public Housing units throughout the City of San Diego (Attachment 1).

FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The ARRA Capital Fund Grant will provide \$2,173,051 in Federal funding. These funds will be incorporated into the proposed FY2010 SDHC budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW:

Under applicable federal regulations, the response to the funding application does not require compliance with National Environmental Policy Act at this time. If and when funds are received, in appropriate circumstances, Determinations of Exemption and/or Exclusion will be sought prior to commitment of the funds in accordance with applicable federal regulations. The application for a federal grant is "not a project" under the provision of the State of California Environmental Quality Act guidelines.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT AND AUTHORIZE THE PROPOSED USE OF THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REIVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) PUBLIC HOUSING CAPITAL FUND GRANT (CITYWIDE)

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2009, President Barak Obama signed into effect the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) providing \$4 billion for the Public Housing Capital Fund to carry out capital and management activities for Public Housing Agencies; and

WHEREAS, on or about February 24, 2009, the San Diego Housing Commission (the "Commission") was notified that it is eligible to receive \$2,173,051 in ARRA Grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has prepared the Capital Fund Grant Program Annual Statement in accordance with the U.S. Department of Housing And Urban Development Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, this document must be submitted in order to receive federal grant funds for improvements to public housing units and the acquisition and/or development of same;

WHEREAS, to expedite the acquisition of properties for public housing, the San Diego Housing Commission plans to use the authorization in its Amended and Restated Moving to Work Agreement to acquire sites without prior HUD approval, provided that the Commission certifies HUD site selection requirements have been met, subject to HUD approval of an amendment to the Commission's Moving to Work Demonstration Annual Plan allowing use of this authorization;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the San Diego Housing Commission, as follows:

That the President & Chief Executive Officer of the San Diego Housing Commission or designee

is authorized to accept the ARRA Public Housing Capital Fund Grant and Board of the

Commission further authorizes the proposed use of same as presented under Housing

Commission Report No. HCR09-033. In addition, the President & Chief Executive Officer is

authorized to take any and all actions and to execute any and all documents as are reasonably

necessary to implement this approval; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Director of the San Diego Housing

Commission or his designee is hereby authorized to submit to HUD for its approval, the attached

proposed amendment to the Commission's Moving to Work Demonstration Annual Plan for

fiscal 2009, which would allow the Commission to acquire sites for public housing with formula

public housing capital funds provided under the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act of

2009 without prior HUD approval.
