



## LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS

### Federal

- SDHC provided a letter in support of U.S. Senator Alex Padilla's proposed legislation, the Housing for All Act, which would provide essential resources for addressing the homelessness and affordable housing crises in the City of San Diego and nationwide.
- SDHC submitted a Congressionally Directed Spending application to U.S. Senator Laphonza Butler and a Community Project Funding application to U.S. Representative Scott Peters.

### State

- SDHC joined the California Home Building Alliance (HBA) in supporting Assembly Bill (AB) 2140 from Assemblymember Juan Carrillo, AB 3057 from Assemblymember Lori Wilson, and Senate Bills (SB) 1077 and 1092 from Senator Catherine Blakespear.
- SDHC legislative consultant Lighthouse Public Affairs met with the offices of several California Senate and Assembly Members, including Senator Catherine Blakespear, Senator Anna Caballero, new Senate Housing Committee Chair Senator Nancy Skinner, Senator Toni Atkins, Assemblymember Alex Lee, Chair of Assembly Local Government Committee Assemblymember Juan Carrillo, Chair of Assembly Housing Committee Assemblymember Chris Ward, Chair of Assembly Appropriations Assemblymember Buffy Wicks, and Assemblymember David Alvarez. Lighthouse also met with the committee consultants in Assembly Housing and Community Development Committee, Assembly Local Government Committee, and Senate Local Government Committee.
- Lighthouse Public Affairs provided comment on SDHC's behalf during the Senate Budget Subcommittee 4 hearing on March 14.
