

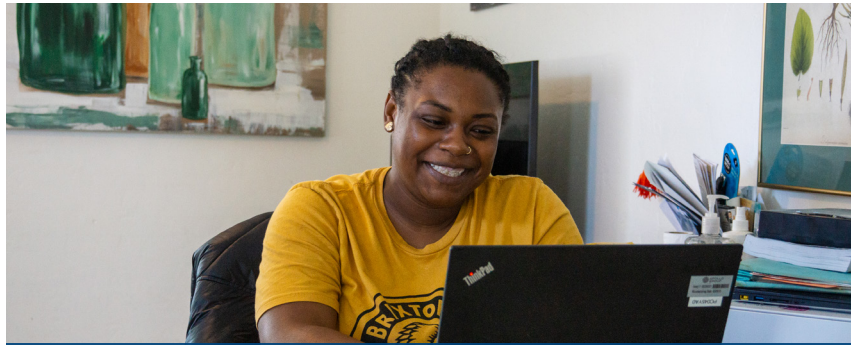


SDHC Moving Home Rapid Rehousing Program

The San Diego Housing Commission's (SDHC) Moving Home Rapid Rehousing program helps individuals and families who are experiencing homelessness due to an unexpected life experience, such as a job loss, domestic violence or a medical crisis.

Moving Home program participants are identified and referred through the Regional Task Force on Homelessness' (RTFH) Coordinated Entry System. Participants, who are living on the street or in shelters, will receive assistance to move into housing as quickly as possible and supportive services to stabilize in housing.

SDHC Moving Home is a program of HOUSING FIRST – SAN DIEGO, SDHC's homelessness initiative.

Rental and Moving-Related Assistance

- Security deposits
- Overdue, unpaid rent and utility expenses if they present a housing barrier
- Temporary rental assistance for up to two years utilizing a step-down rental portion approach
- Moving costs
- Assistance obtaining necessary documents, such as identification cards
- Identifying and addressing barriers to becoming a tenant
- Housing search assistance
- Reviewing rental and lease agreements
- Obtaining basic furnishings and household supplies
- Connecting to community resources

Maintaining Stable Housing

- Working with tenants and landlords to resolve issues
- Building tenants' skills for communicating with landlords
- Developing a plan to keep stable, permanent housing including increasing income
- Referring tenants to resources, such as credit counseling, child care and employment resources
- Reviewing participants' income and creating an honest budget reviewed on a regular basis
