

SAN DIEGO HOUSING COMMISSION MOVING TO WORK

PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2026 ANNUAL PLAN SUMMARY

This document provides a summary of the San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC) Moving to Work (MTW) Draft Annual Plan for Fiscal Year 2026 (July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026). The draft plan is available at www.sdhc.org/moving-to-work, and public comments may be submitted through January 23, 2025.

MOVING TO WORK

SDHC is one of only 39 original MTW agencies out of approximately 3,200 public housing authorities in the nation. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has announced the addition of 100 MTW agencies nationwide. MTW status gives SDHC the flexibility to implement innovative, cost-effective ways to provide housing assistance and increase housing choice in the City of San Diego.

Each year, SDHC is required to develop an MTW Annual Plan that is submitted to HUD for approval. The MTW Annual Plan includes details on the number of people and households planned to be served within the fiscal year; planned changes in housing stock, leasing and waiting lists; and summaries of sources and uses of MTW funding.

The MTW Annual Plan also contains descriptions of MTW activities previously approved by HUD in addition to any proposals for new activities and updates to existing activities.

FY 2026 ANNUAL PLAN UPDATES AND PROPOSALS

SDHC is not proposing any new activities in FY 2026.

MTW ANNUAL PLAN PUBLIC COMMENT

SDHC invites the public to review and provide comments on its draft FY 2026 MTW Annual Plan. All comments will be considered during the final review of the proposed MTW Annual Plan and will become part of the public record submitted to HUD.
