An informational workshop will be presented regarding the Fiscal Year 2026 Moving to Work (MTW) Annual Plan Amendment. No action will be taken on this item.

The San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC) is one of only 39 original MTW agencies out of approximately 3,200 public housing authorities in the nation. As a result, SDHC has the ability to seek approval from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to implement a variety of innovative new approaches to provide affordable housing assistance and other services to low-income families within the City of San Diego. The SDHC Board of Commissioners (Board) approved the Fiscal Year 2026 MTW Annual Plan on February 14, 2025. The proposed Fiscal Year 2026 MTW Annual Plan Amendment (Plan Amendment) includes updates to SDHC's Path to Success initiative to adjust the method of calculating the family contribution toward rent for rental assistance and public housing participants.
